WHEREAS, the Board has determined that it is in the best interest of the children and taxpayers of the North Haledon School District to amend its resolution dated June 12, 2014, referenced above, to approve the attached agreement between the Board and NB Annex IV, Inc. doing business as New Beginnings at Memorial School with respect to the operation of a school at Memorial School.
